

REGISTRATION OF MORTGAGES, PROHIBITIONS OR OTHER ENCUMBRANCE

It is the process by which the registration of legal acts that affect the domain of the aircraft is accredited, guaranteeing the obligations contracted allowing it to have legal value against third parties and that is practiced in the Registry of Encumbrances and Prohibitions.

The registration of a mortgage, prohibition or other encumbrance in the Registry may be requested by the interested party who is empowered to carry out said procedure (creditor, debtor or a third party, as appropriate), who must present the following information:

- Application to the National Aircraft Registry

- Public Deed or private instrument authorized before a Public Notary where the mortgage, the prohibition or the corresponding lien is constituted.

- Payment of the registration fees, in accordance with the amounts indicated in article 39, c) of the Aeronautical Fees and Duties Regulations.
